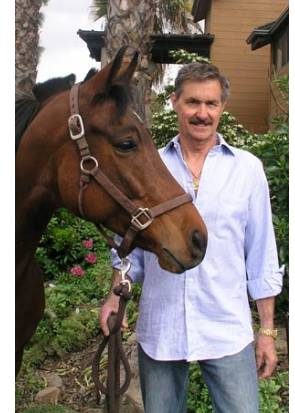
Three talented Coronado artists featured in the C3 Gallery
