

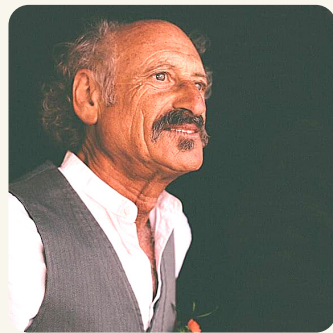




### **CHARADE (1963, 113 mins)**
