Excerpt from Cindy Wilson's recent editorial in the Eagle Journal Newspaper:

"As far as I can tell, all of the candidates seeking seats on the Coronado Unified School District Board of Trustees seem to be well-intentioned men and women; all seem sincere in their beliefs. Where candidates differ is: 1) in their assessments and understanding of current state of public education, nationally, and locally in Coronado's public schools, and 2) their prescription for the wisest "way ahead" to provide the best possible public education opportunity to Coronado's students.

This oversimplifies, but after listening carefully to the candidates in a variety of public forums, one concludes they hold to one of two general convictions: 1) those who are well-pleased with current curriculum, protocols, and the performance of Coronado's public schools. For the most part, these candidates see no urgent necessity to examine, question or alter the existing approaches now advanced by school administrators and 2) those for whom COVID restrictions offered a troubling glimpse at these existing approaches and national trends who found they were deeply disturbed by both content they viewed as entirely inappropriate for their children and the troubling lack of focus on traditional academic disciplines. That lack of focus resulted in the misuse of Coronado students' precious, limited academic instructional minutes...."
