



## CITY OF CORONADO

### 2026 PRIORITY LEGISLATIVE GOALS

#### 1. Eliminate Cross Border Water Pollution

- Support Federal and State funding for wastewater treatment, water conservation, flood control and other treatment infrastructure and facilities, and environmental mitigation and restoration projects to prevent cross-border water pollution.
- Advocate for and support negotiations with Mexico to fix/improve/fund Mexican wastewater treatment, flood control projects and other infrastructure causes of cross-border water pollution, and impose defined accountability measures for any future degradation, or lack of maintenance or upscaling, of treatment infrastructure.
- Advocate for accurate water quality testing procedures that properly inform of water conditions without creating unnecessary water closures.

#### 2. Increase Infrastructure Funding for Storm Water, Wastewater, Recycled Water and Major Capital Projects

- Support legislation that provides funding for recycled water, wastewater and storm water infrastructure.
- Support legislation funding and streamlining major capital projects such as utility undergrounding, solar panels, vehicle charging stations, parks rehabilitation, coastline remediation, fire station construction and climate resiliency.

#### 3. Implement Reasonable 7<sup>th</sup> Cycle Regional Housing Need Assessment (RHNA) Projections and Policies

- Require HCD and Regional Planning Agencies to consider local context and growth limitations imposed by other state and regional planning agencies when analyzing Housing Elements, and to provide greater flexibility to meet RHNA goals and assure finality upon certification of a Housing Element.
- Support legislation that amends RHNA law or implementation to accurately distribute military jobs across jurisdictions and provide cities with full credit for housing units on adjacent military installations.
- Oppose legislation that penalizes a city in any way if units identified in the Regional Housing Need Assessment are not constructed.

#### 4. Allow for Local Establishment of E-Bike Regulations

- Support legislation that confers regulatory authority for e-bikes to local agencies.
