Requirements:

- 1) Applicant must be a graduating senior registered at Coronado High School
- 2) Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, please include appropriate proof of GPA in your application
- 3) Applicant shall include a description of any community service and leadership experience in which he or she has been involved
- 4) Completed application including essay.
