- ☞ **"The Optimist Young Peacemaker Award"** (sponsored by the Optimists Club of Coronado)  
An elementary or middle school student or recognized group of students in Coronado who value, model, and promote peace in human relationships on and off campus
  
- ☞ **"The James Richard Shirey, Jr. Memorial Peacemaker Award"** (sponsored by an anonymous donor)  
A Coronado High School student or recognized group of students who value, model, and promote peace in human relationships on and off campus
  
- ☞ **"Coronado Chamber of Commerce Peacemaker Award"** (sponsored by the Coronado Chamber of Commerce)  
An individual or entity in the Coronado business community who effectively models and contributes to improving communication and to the peaceful resolution of conflict within the business community
  
- ☞ **"The Rotary Peacemaker Award"** (sponsored by the Rotary Club of Coronado)  
A civic-minded volunteer (individual or group) who substantially and verifiably contributes to improving communication and to the peaceful resolution of conflict within organizations and/or in the community at large
  
- ☞ **"Sybil Stockdale Peacemaker Award"** (co-sponsored by the Silver Strand Chapter, Military Officers Association of America and the Coronado Council Navy League)  
An individual who is active duty military and stationed in Coronado; and who, in the course of duty, effectively models and contributes to improving communication and the peaceful resolution of conflict within the military community
  
- ☞ **"Community Peacemaker Award"**  
A public servant – pastor, coach, teacher, counselor, police officer, fireman, etc. – who, in the course of his or her duties, effectively models and contributes to improving communication and the peaceful resolution of conflict
  
- ☞ **"The Coronado Peacemaker Award"**  
A family member, acquaintance, friend, neighbor, colleague, etc.; postal worker, grocery clerk, secretary, salesperson, restaurant server, etc.; who lives or works in Coronado and values, models, and promotes peaceful human relationships
